

195CE Internship Courses

QUICK GUIDE

Program Overview

The Center for Community Engagement partners with academic departments to offer several 195CE internship courses through remote instruction. Students earn upper-division academic credit (4 units) for internship work with an off-campus corporate, non-profit, or government agency. Students can enroll for a letter grade or pass/no-pass. Departments decide which quarters their 195CE course is offered and may have additional eligibility requirements (e.g. open to all majors vs majors/minors only). Student Eligibility

- Must have a junior or senior standing (at least 90 or more units completed)
- 3.0 GPA requirement
- Good academic standing
- International students on the F-1 visa should first contact the <u>Dashew</u> <u>Center</u>, as they may not begin their internship without an approved CPT authorization request.

Course Requirements

- Weekly reading/writing assignments
- 5 bi-weekly meetings with a Graduate Student Instructor
- · Final research paper
- Minimum of 80 internship hours completed (8-10 hours per week)

Internship Site Eligibility*

- A minimum of 80 internship hours over at least 8 weeks of the quarter
- Off-campus workplace
- Supervision by professional staff
- May be paid or unpaid
- May be in person or remote

*Internships are secured **prior** to course enrollment. <u>Eligibility</u> is verified during the intake appointment with a Graduate Student Instructor.

Enrollment Process

An intake appointment is required for enrollment into a 195CE course and can only be scheduled during an open enrollment period. Enrollment occurs on a rolling basis and is first come, first served. Enrollment dates and step by step instructions can be found on our website's enrollment page.
