

## **UCLA Department of English Honors Thesis Release to English Reading Room**

The UCLA Department of English seeks permission of all participants of its Departmental Honors Program to place the unmarked file (3rd) copies of their completed honors theses in the Grace M. Hunt Memorial English Reading Room (hereafter ERR--located at 235A Kaplan). Theses placed on file will be made available only to future enrolled participants of the English Departmental Honors Program and teaching faculty of the department for a period of no more than 5 years. Theses that are placed on file will be identified by author name, advisor name, academic year of participation in the departmental honors program, and as having received either "honors" or "highest honors," as well as an additional notation identifying winners of the Thompson Prize for best honors thesis. In addition, each thesis may be bound or re-bound for ease of shelving.

No honors thesis will be placed in the ERR until after the end of the quarter during which the thesis is submitted to the advisor of record for a final grade. If you decide to grant permission for your honors thesis to be placed on file in the ERR, you may revoke that permission at any time in the future by writing or calling the Undergraduate Counseling Office at (310) 825-1389 or the English Reading Room at (310) 825-4511. Theses not filed in the ERR will be placed in confidential files maintained by the English Undergraduate Counseling Office.
